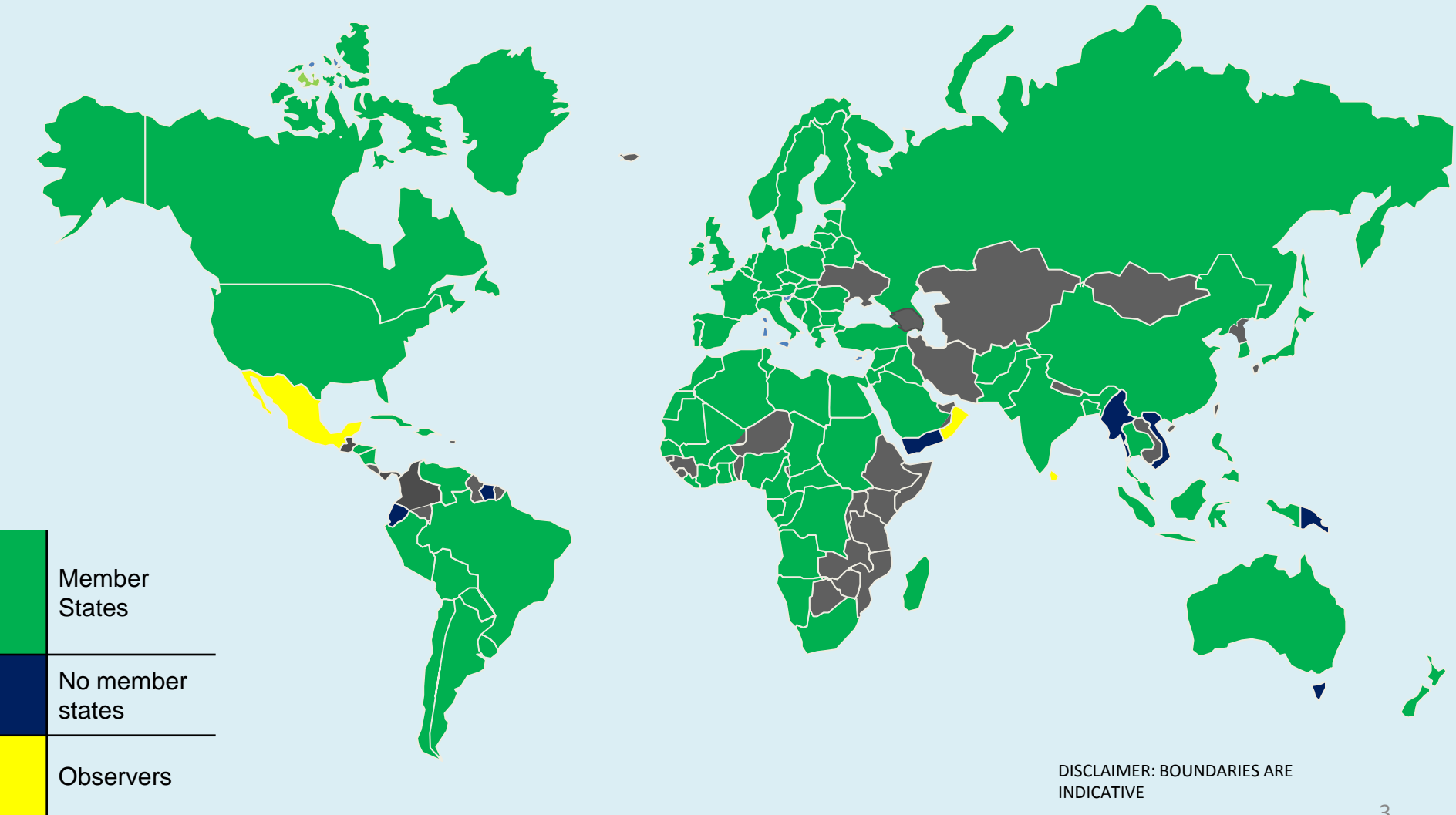

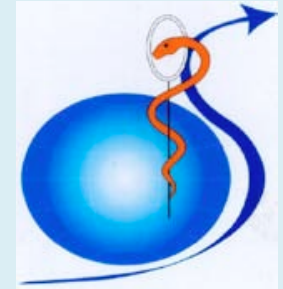
ICMM Pan-Asia Pacific Symposium of Medical Relief in Disasters

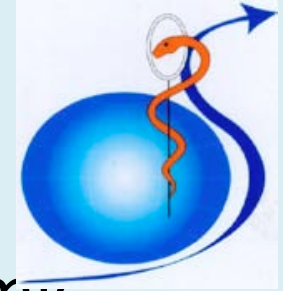
